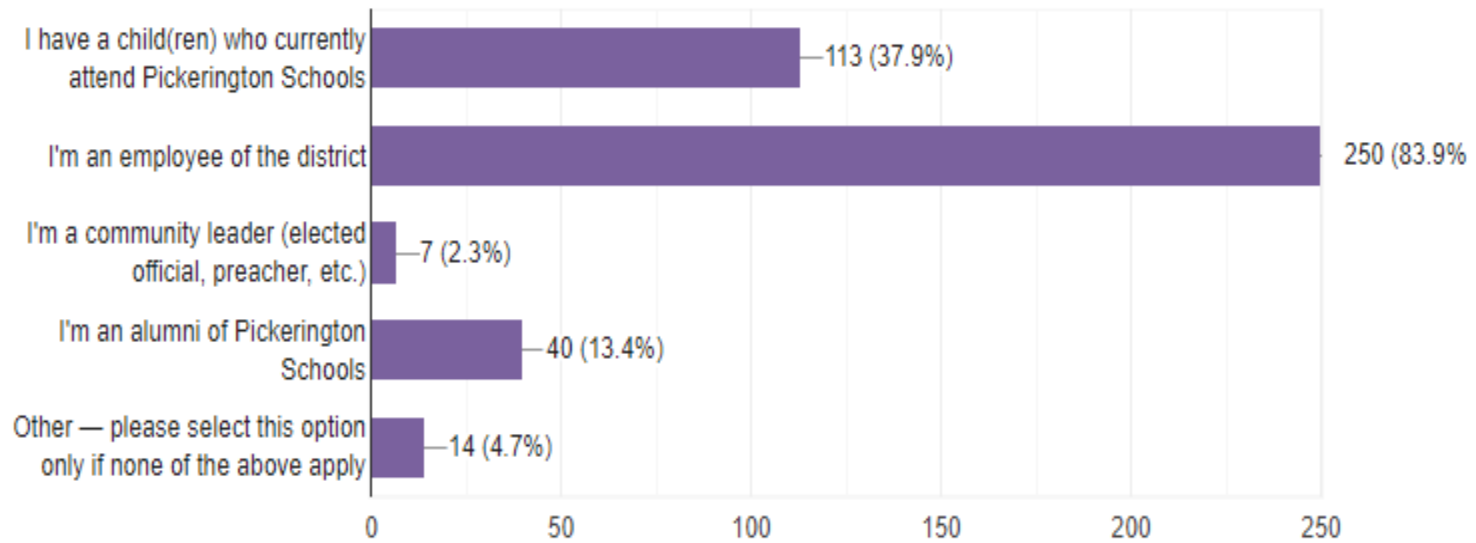


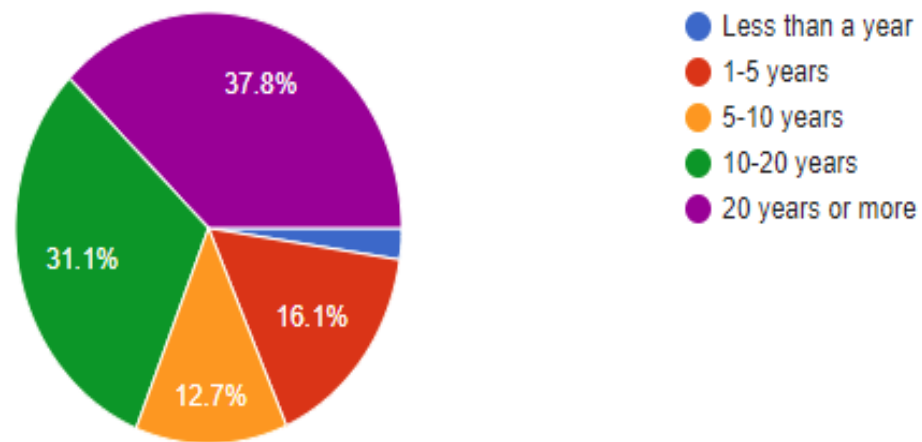
What is your relationship to Pickerington Schools (PLSD)? (please select all that apply)

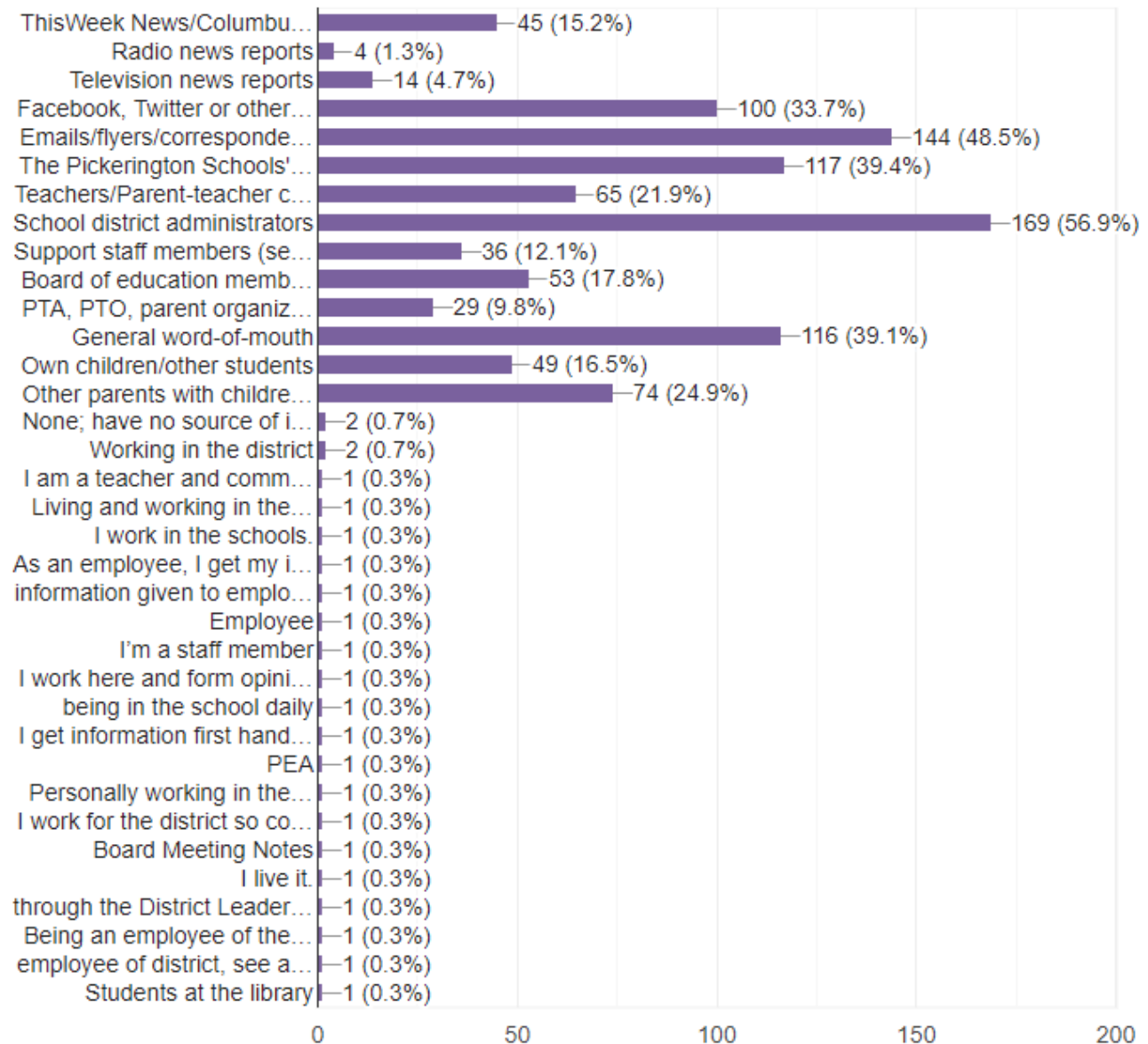
How many years have you had a relationship with Pickerington Schools (How long have your kids been in school at PLSD, how long have you lived/worked in the community, etc.)?

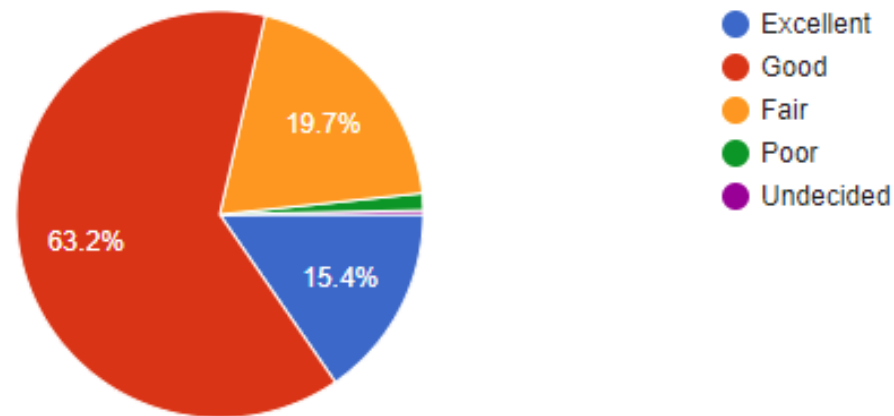
Where do you get the information that influences your opinions the most about Pickerington Schools? (please select your top three answers)

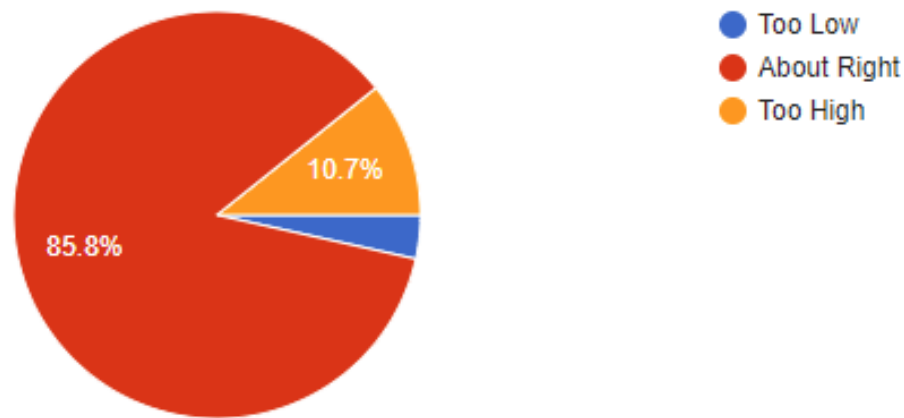
Overall, how would you rate the condition of the existing school buildings, facilities, property and grounds that are owned and operated by Pickerington Schools ?

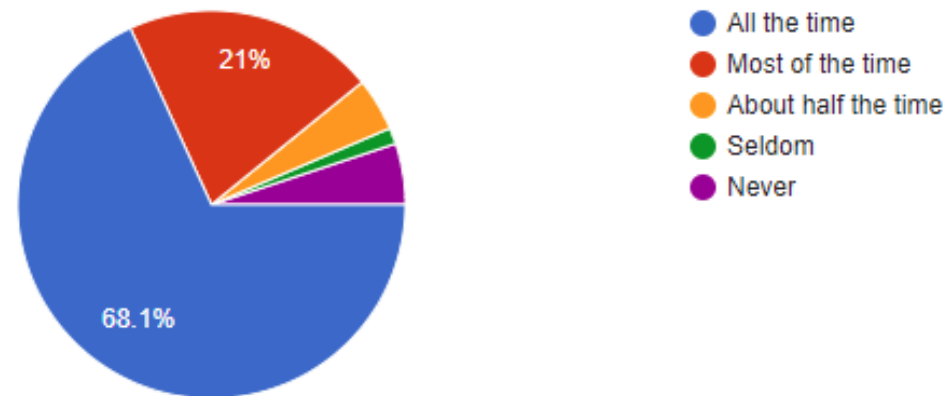

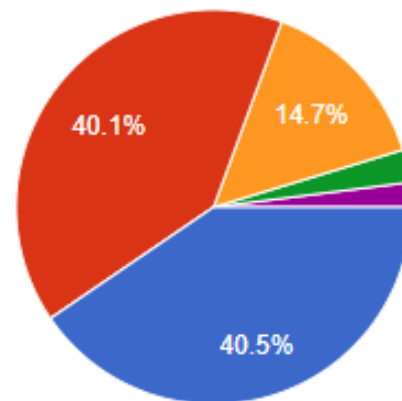

Based upon the information presented, how do you feel about the proposal?

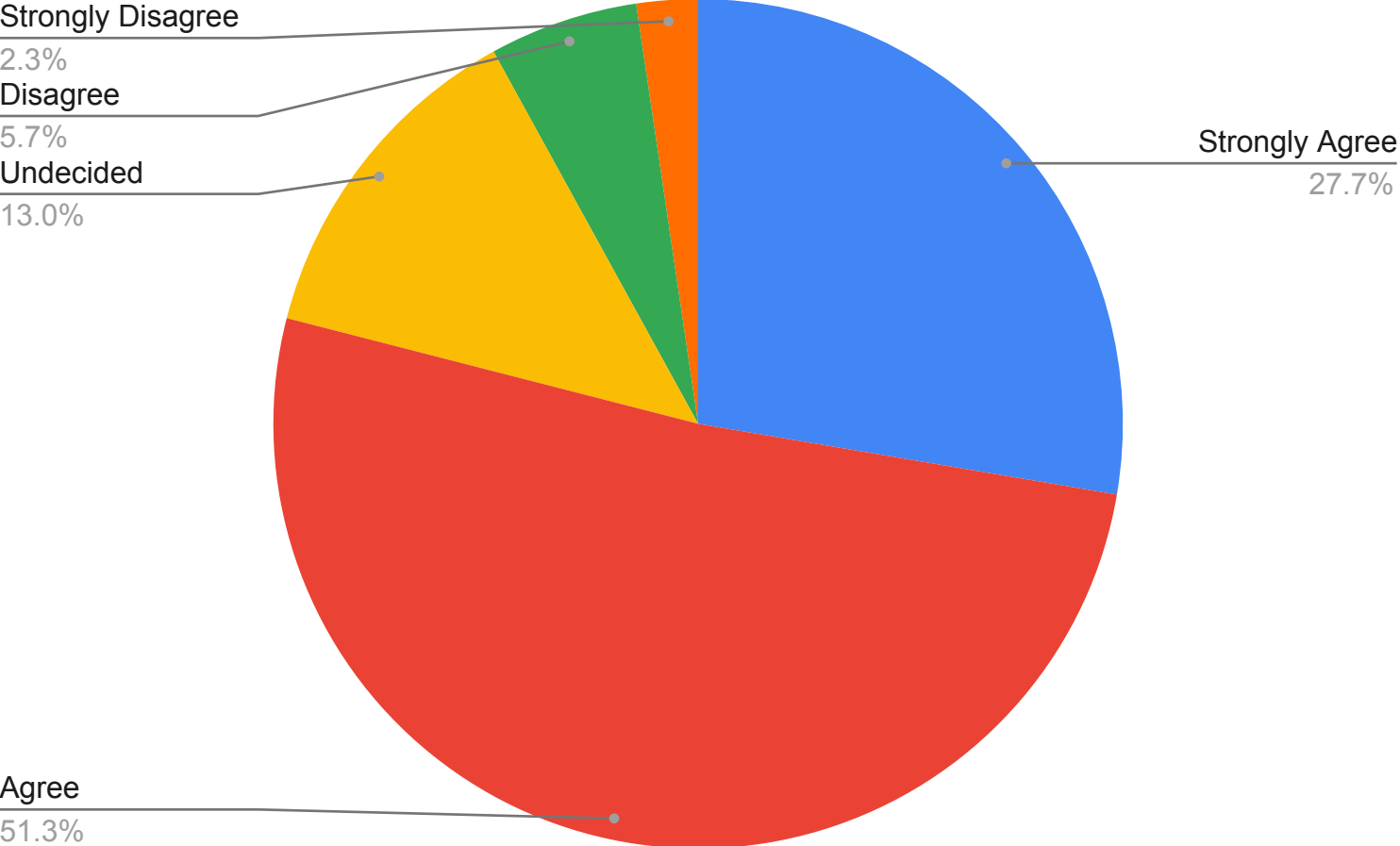
